Eye Witness comprising solely of family members declared that the killing was purely the result of accidental discharge of a shot gun in the hands of young Alexander who was cleaning the gun....further inquiry is pending. The deceased was a native of Venice where he was born some fifty years ago the son of Mr. & Mrs. Clement BURAS. He leaves a widow and five children, and one brother.
